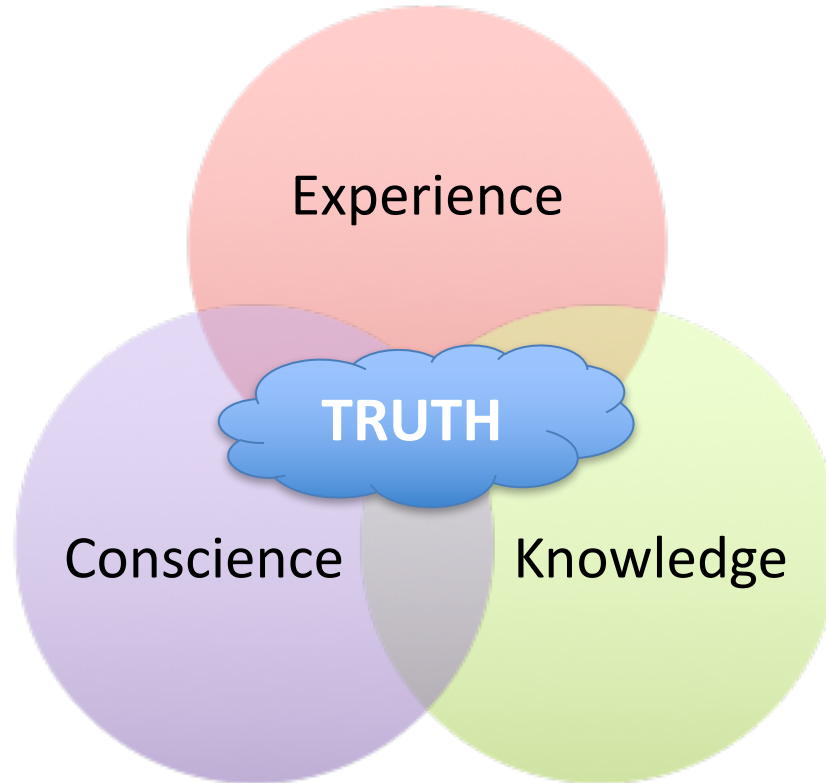
How do we know God exists?

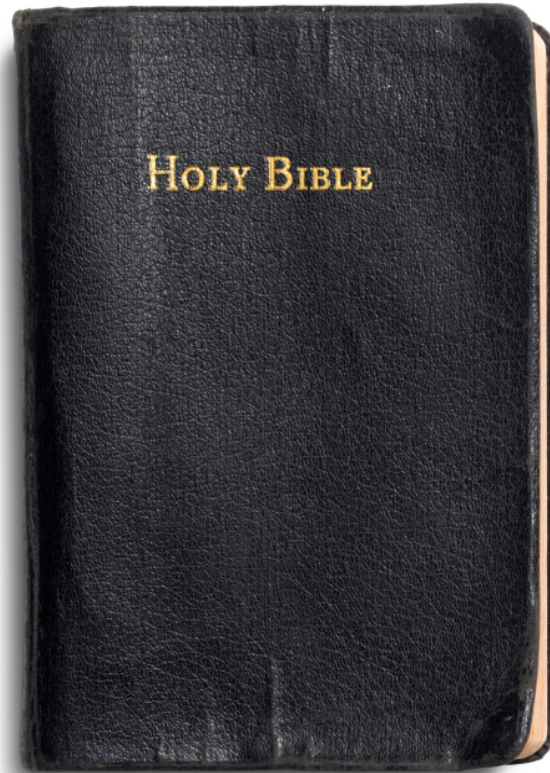

Considering the historical evidence, it is reasonable to believe the Bible is an accurate translation of the original writings and has been preserved through the ages of history.



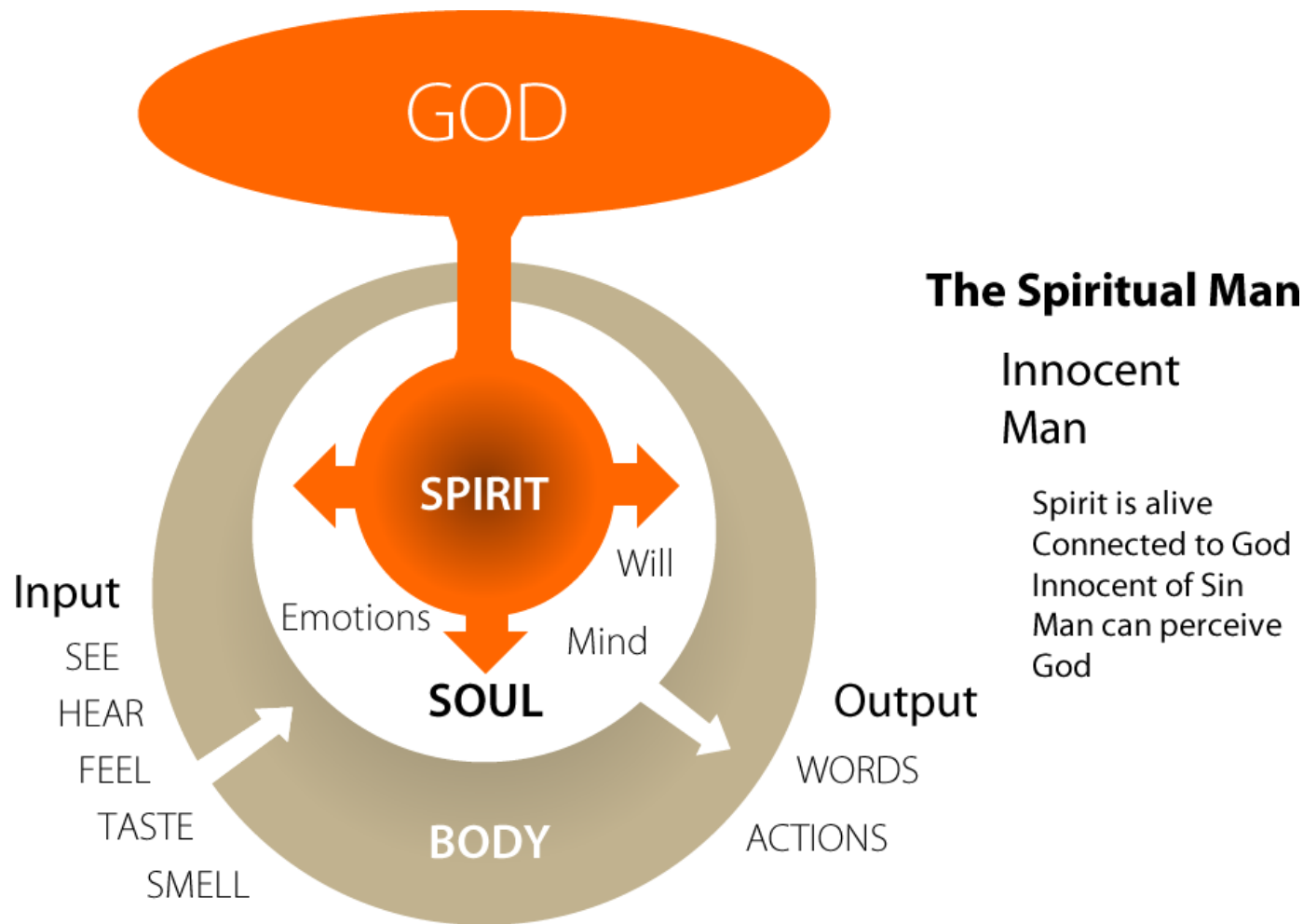
The Bible contains one story:

Genesis



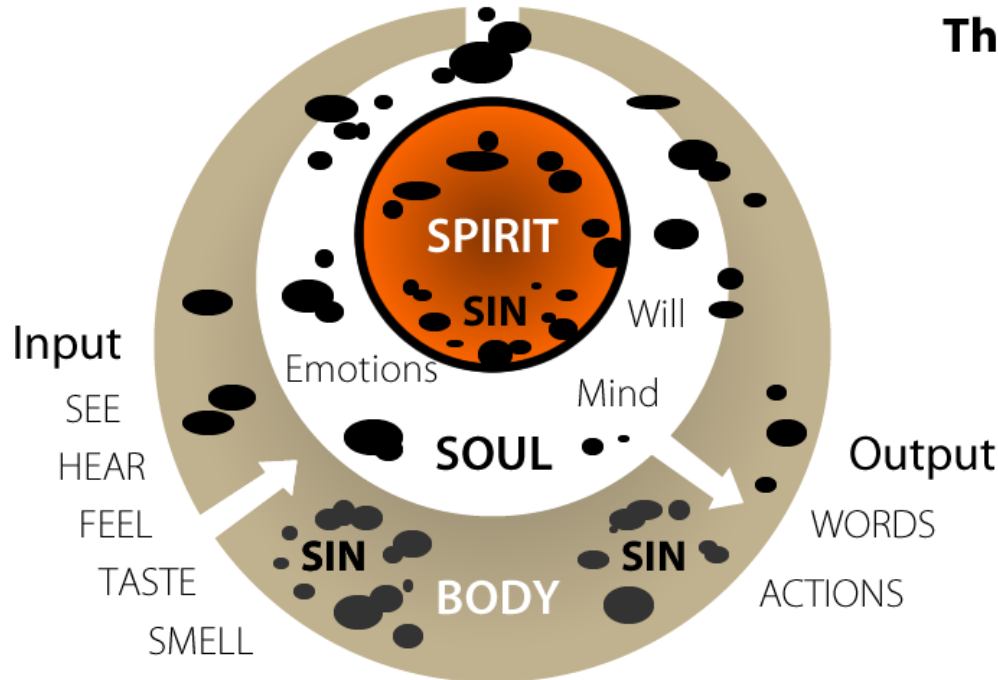


Human beings are made of three
