to us, we must be born again.

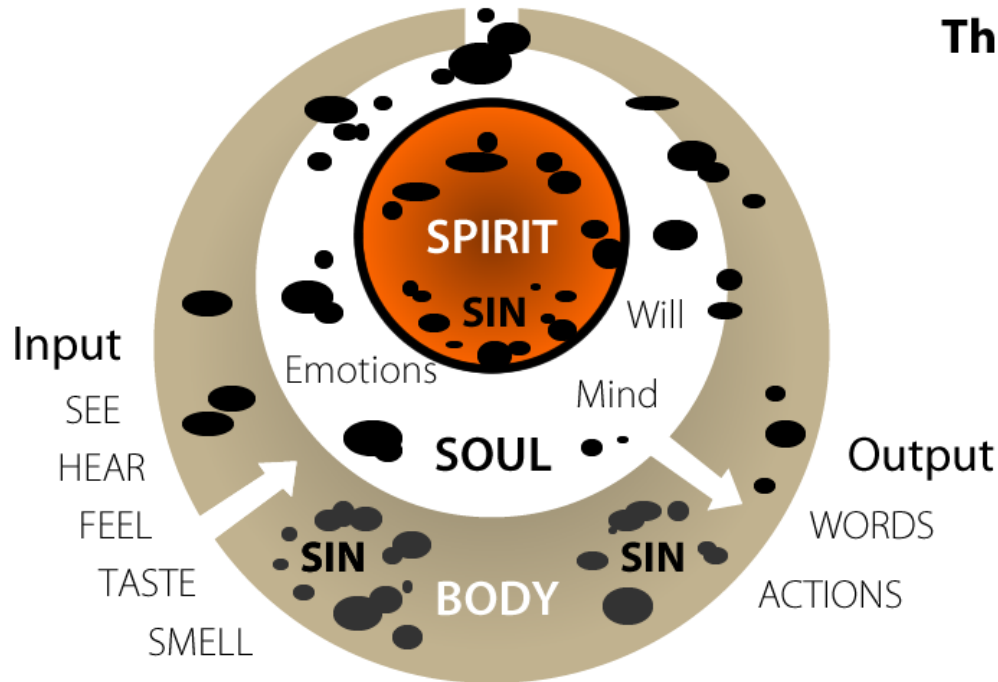


Being born again is a process of

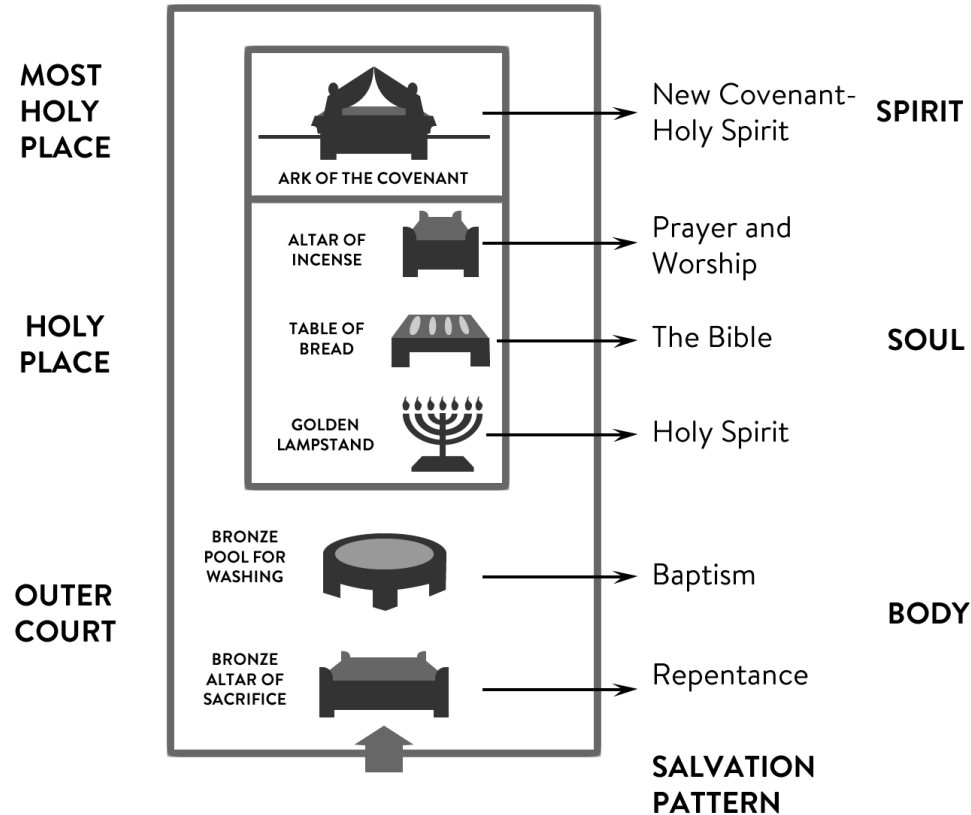


The Spiritual Man
